TWO OPTIONS

The Power of Collective Giving - **With a gift of \$10,000 or more, your scholarship fund can be invested with LCF's endowment**, and the spendable amount will be joined with others to provide more students in Lincoln and Lancaster County with essential funds to attend college.

With a gift of \$50,000 or more, our LCF team will work with you to create more specific criteria for your scholarship. For example, you may create a fund that benefits students pursuing a defined course of study or attending a specific high school within Lincoln and Lancaster County.

For both options, LCF's experienced and sophisticated Finance Committee provides professional oversight of our portfolio's investment managers. Experienced in investment strategies, the committee keeps a watchful eye on asset allocation, portfolio performance, and investment fees to ensure long-term growth.
